PAUL RUDD

Before becoming Ant-Man in the Marvel film franchise, he played iconic roles on *Friends* and the *Wet Hot American Summer* series, and starred in films from *Clueless* and *Romeo + Juliet* to *This is 40*, *Anchorman* and *The Fundamentals of Caring*. His extensive career boasts actor, writer and producer credits.



KIM CATTRALL

Winner of a Golden Globe and five Emmy nominations, she is recognized for lead roles in HBO's *Sex and the City* and *Sensitive Skin*. She has starred in *Mannequin*, *Star Trek VI*, *Producing Parker* and on Broadway and London stages. Currently, she is on the Swedish series *Modus* and the CBS All Access series *Tell Me A Story*.



ADRIEN BRODY

After starring in the critically acclaimed films *The Thin Red Line* and *Summer of Sam*, he became the youngest winner of the Best Actor Oscar for *The Pianist*. He followed with the blockbuster *King Kong*, and then went on to star in *The Village*, *Midnight in Paris*, *Grand Budapest Hotel* and *Houdini*.



DENNIS HAYSBERT

Known for his roles on *24* and *The Unit*, his distinctive voice is in the animated films *Kung Fu Panda* and *Wreck-It Ralph*. He is the commercial spokesperson for Allstate Insurance, and recently starred in the films *The Dark Tower* and *Fist Fight*. This year, he starred in the Netflix thriller *Secret Obsession*.



JESSICA CHASTAIN

After earning two Oscar nominations for her performances in *The Help* and *Zero Dark Thirty*, she received Golden Globe nominations for her roles in *The Most Violent Year* and *Miss Sloane*. Recently, she starred in *The Zookeeper's Wife* and *Molly's Game*. She is currently cast in *It: Chapter 2*.



ARTURO CASTRO

Creator and star of *Alternatino*, a sketch comedy show on Comedy Central, he's also known for playing David Rodriguez in the Golden Globe-nominated *Narcos* on Netflix. Other credits include a leading role in the war drama *Billy Lynn's Long Halftime Walk* by Academy Award-winner Ang Lee.



SARAH PAULSON

Starring on the FX limited series *American Crime Story*, she won an Emmy, Golden Globe and SAG award, in addition to her performance on *American Horror Story*, for which she earned multiple Emmy and Golden Globe nominations. Her film credits include *Mud*, *12 Years a Slave*, *Carol*, *Rebel in the Rye* and *Ocean's 8*.



CONSTANCE ZIMMER

Acclaimed for her role as Quinn on Lifetime's *UnREAL*, and as Dana Gordon on HBO's hit series *Entourage*, the Emmy-nominated actress has starred on Netflix's *House of Cards*, *Boston Legal* and has recurred on Marvel's *Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D.*, and *Grey's Anatomy*. Currently, she stars in ABC's *A Million Little Things*.


ADAM SCOTT
